Located just 30 minutes south of the world's busiest airport in Atlanta, Georgia, is a hidden gem of a small town called Chattahoochee Hills.

Untouched by sprawl and mega development, this community made an intentional decision to preserve its rural heritage when it incorporated in 2007.

The Chatt Hills Barn Quilt Trail was created in 2020 as a community art project to share the heritage of our city. Each painted quilt is displayed on a building or barn, and each tells the story of the family and its history on the webpage's Tour the Trail page (click on each barn quilt for its story.)

We invite you to take a self-guided tour by either following the suggested route below, or by creating your own route.

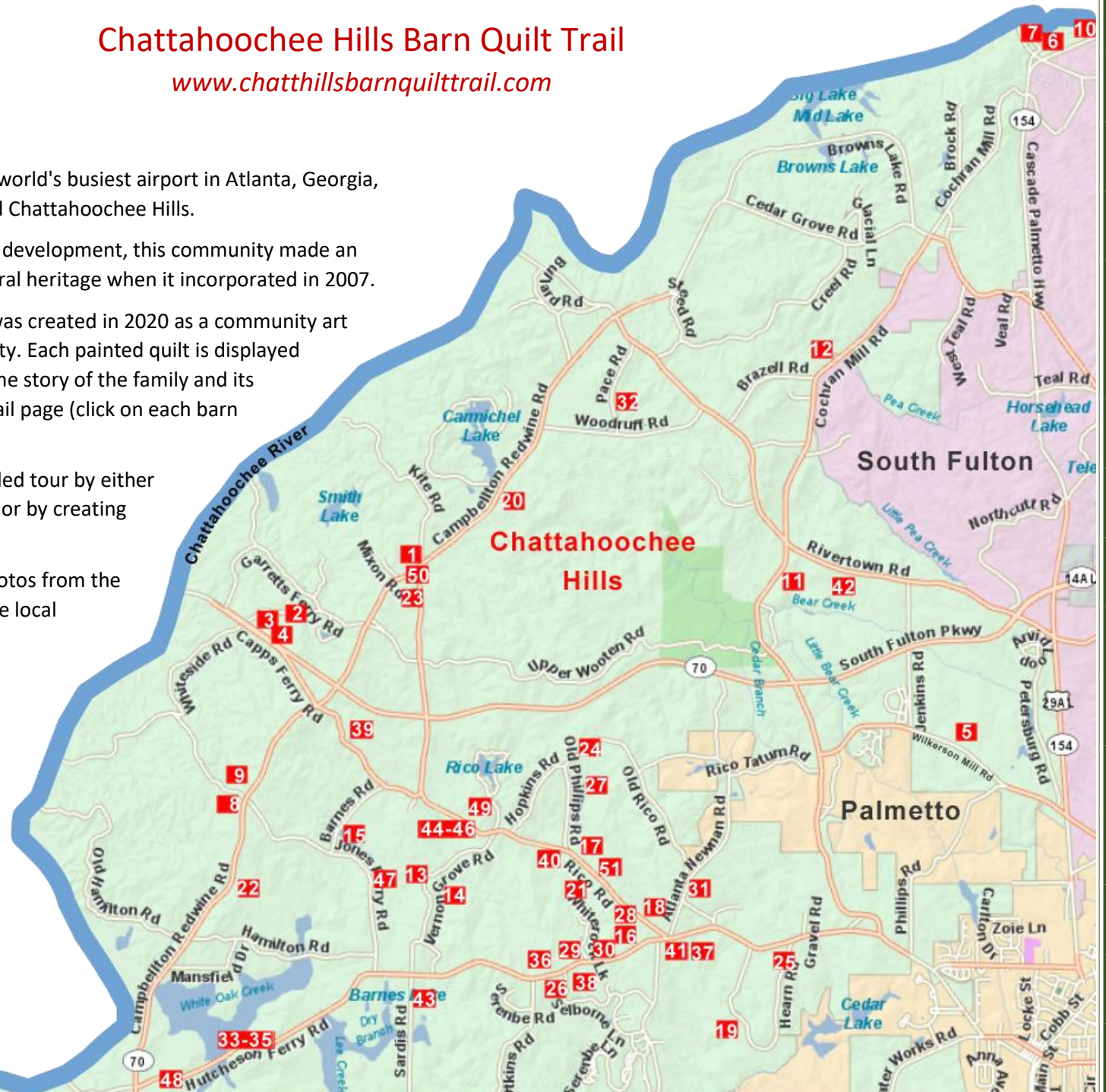
Visitors are welcome to take photos from the public road, and are invited to visit the local stores, businesses, and parks.
