



Chatt Hills Barn Quilt Trail Status Report – March 16, 2021

QUILT TRAIL UPDATE

Barn Quilts Completed

Since the February 2021 report, two additional barn quilts have been created and added to the quilt trail, bringing the total number of barn quilts to 14.

Mt. Vernon Farm Barn Quilt 1 was installed at 8095 Vernon Grove Rd (on their first barn) on March 13, 2021. The 6x6 ft barn quilt was painted by Laurie Searle and installed on the barn by Sam Smith. The quilt pattern is “Martha Washington’s Star” in honor of the family’s patriotic name (George Washington Star.)

Vernon Grove is a gravel road well-traveled by bicyclists riding the Dirty Sheets Bicycle Route. During the hour-long installation, we counted at least 20 cyclists who rode by. In the first hour after posting this to our Facebook page, it reached 940 people.

Mt. Vernon Barn Quilt 2 was installed at 8095 Vernon Grove Rd (on their second barn) on March 13, 2021. The 6x6 ft barn quilt was a custom design painted by Laurie Searle and installed on the barn by Sam Smith. The quilt pattern is called “Thoroughbred) in honor of the race horses the family raises.

Two barn quilts were installed at this location due to the size of the property (160 acres), which has two very large barns very close to the road. Vernon Grove Rd is on the Dirty Sheets Bicycle Route and so these barn quilts will be seen by many visitors and residents in our city. In the first hour after posting this to our Facebook page, it reached 738 people.

Barn Quilts in Progress

The following barn quilts are in the planning or painting stage:

1. **Dallas Nevins** at 8115 Piney Woods Church Rd. They are in the process of selecting their final design, which will feature a tree and pinecones. The family will assist in the painting of their barn quilt, which will be placed on their large green barn near the road. We may need Greystone Power to install this one, possibly at the same time as StudioSwan.
2. **StudioSwan** at 5401 Campbellton Redwine Rd (in the old Masonic Lodge.) They have submitted pattern called "Thistle Bloom" which their artists will paint. We may need Greystone Power to install this one.
3. **Pat & Kay Long** at 6430 Mixon Rd. They have selected a Maple Leaf quilt design, which will measure 4x4 ft.
4. **John & Terri Taylor** at 9275 Wilkerson Mill Rd. They are in the process of selecting their final design. It will be placed on their older barn near at the front of their property by the road.
5. **BreeAnne Clowdus & Courtney Howe** at 7770 Barns Rd. They are in the process of selecting a design.
6. **Claire Williams** inquired about one. She would have to pay for the materials since she is outside of Chatt Hills, but I said I'd be glad to paint one for her.
7. **Carl Bouckaert** is interested in hosting a barn quilt on his barn at the corner of Cedar Grove and Cochran Mill Rd. Several designs have been created and he is in the process of selecting one.
