



Chatt Hills Barn Quilt Trail Status Report – May 21, 2021

QUILT TRAIL UPDATE

Barn Quilts Completed

Since the April 2021 report, two new barn quilts have been added to the barn quilt trail, bringing the total number of barn quilts to 17.

The Tree of Life barn quilt was installed at the Piney Woods Farmstead at 8115 Piney Woods Church Rd on May 6, 2021. The property is owned by Pepper & Gwen Bullock and Ken Lemm & Alec Michaelides.

The barn quilt measures 78x78 inches, and was painted by Laurie Searle. Due to the height of the barn, the Greystone Power crew of Daniel Wix and Craig Earl assisted volunteer Sam Smith in the installation.

This has been the most popular barn quilt to date on our social media, viewed by 10,300 people with 1,210 engagements.

The Flying X barn quilt was installed at the Triple A Farm at 7795 Rico Rd on May 19, 2021. The property is owned by Fuller & Paula Anderson.

The barn quilt measures 96x96 inches (8x8 ft), and was painted by Laurie Searle with assistance from Paula Fuller. Sam Smith did the installation, which was challenging due to the corrugated surface of the barn.

In the two days since this was posted on our social media, it has been viewed by 5,175 people with 637 engagements. It also generated a request from a resident who would like to host a barn quilt.

1. **John & Terri Taylor** at 9275 Wilkerson Mill Rd. They are in the process of selecting the pattern and color for their barn quilt, which will be placed on their older barn near at the front of their property by the road.
2. **Paul Harrison** at 8461 Hearn Rd is interested in hosting a barn quilt. Have followed up with a message to schedule a visit.
3. **Susan Krause & Steve Jarvis** at 7777 Barns road have submitted an application to create their own barn quilt for the trail. Have met with them and to discuss and am awaiting time in their schedule.
4. **Carl Bouckaert** is interested in hosting a barn quilt on his barn at the corner of Cedar Grove and Cochran Mill Rd. Several designs have been created and he is in the process of selecting one. No update as of yet.
5. **StudioSwan** at 5401 Campbellton Redwine Rd (in the old Masonic Lodge.) The have submitted pattern called “Thistle Bloom” which their artists will paint. Awaiting a call back to schedule delivery of the materials.

Off the List – the following have considered barn quilts but decided not to participate at this time.

1. **Fuller Anderson** owns the barn at the old Henley Phillips place at 7970 Rico Rd. He initially wanted a barn quilt there, but thought better of it since the barn (which was built in 1912) is in fragile condition.
2. **Jim & Mary Ellen Eagle** at 7855 Rico Rd initially wanted a barn quilt on their old barn but decided it was too fragile.
3. **Pat & Kay Long** at 6430 Mixon Rd selected a Maple Leaf quilt design, and will paint it on their mother’s barn, which cannot be seen from the road, so it will not be on the quilt trail.
